

How Students Take CAASPP Interim Assessments at Home

Required Software for Student Devices

Students will need access to either the Firefox or Chrome web browser.

Note: Students taking the CAASPP Interim Assessments at home can only do so if authorized and directed by their teacher.

How to Logon to Take an Interim Assessment

1. Open either the Firefox or Chrome web browser.





Figure 1. AIR Assessment mobile launchpad screen

2. Go to <https://mobile.tds.airast.org/Launchpad/>. The mobile launchpad screen appears (figure 1).

- a. In the top box, under “Please select your organization or state,” use the down arrow to select *California*.
 - b. In the second box, under “Choose Your Assessment Program,” use the down arrow to select *California Assessment System*.
3. Select the [OK] button. The *Student Sign-In* screen appears ([figure 2](#)).

4. Enter the following information:
 - a. In the field under *First Name*, students enter their first name only. Students need to use their full first name and not a nickname.
 - b. Under *Student ID*, students enter their state ID number. Instructions on how to find this number should be provided by the school or school district.
 - c. In the *Session ID* field, students enter the session ID provided by their teacher.

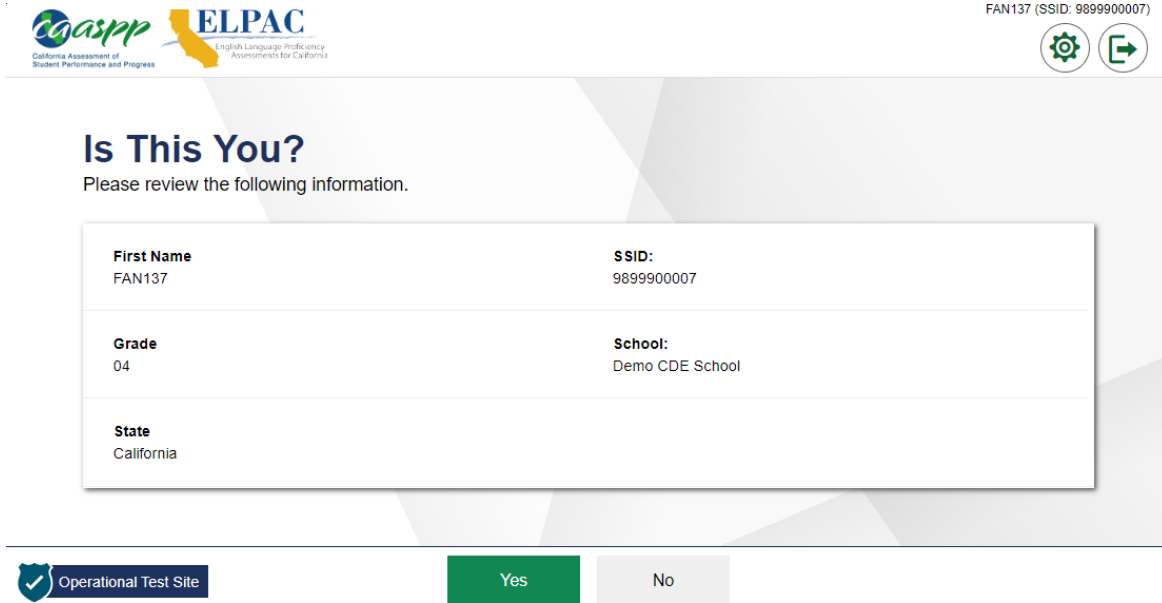


Figure 3. *Is This You?* screen

5. Select the **[Sign In]** button. The *Is This You?* screen appears (figure 3).

6. If all the information on the *Is This You?* screen is correct, select the [Yes] button to move on. The *Your Tests* screen appears. **If any of the information is incorrect, let the teacher know.**

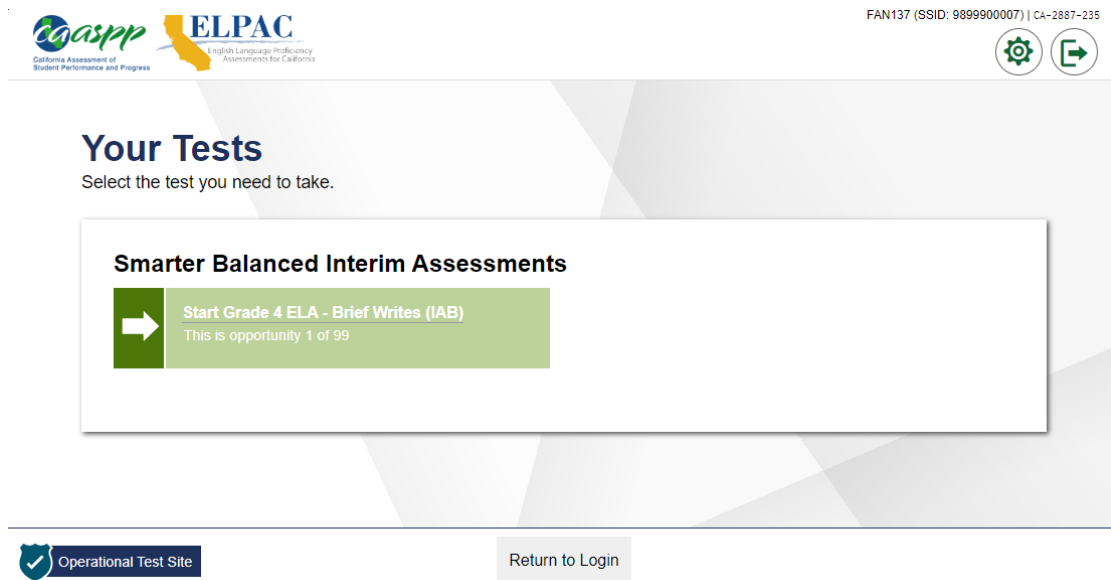


Figure 4. *Your Tests* screen

7. On the *Your Tests* screen (figure 4), choose an interim assessment by selecting the green arrow.

How Students Take CAASPP Interim Assessments at Home

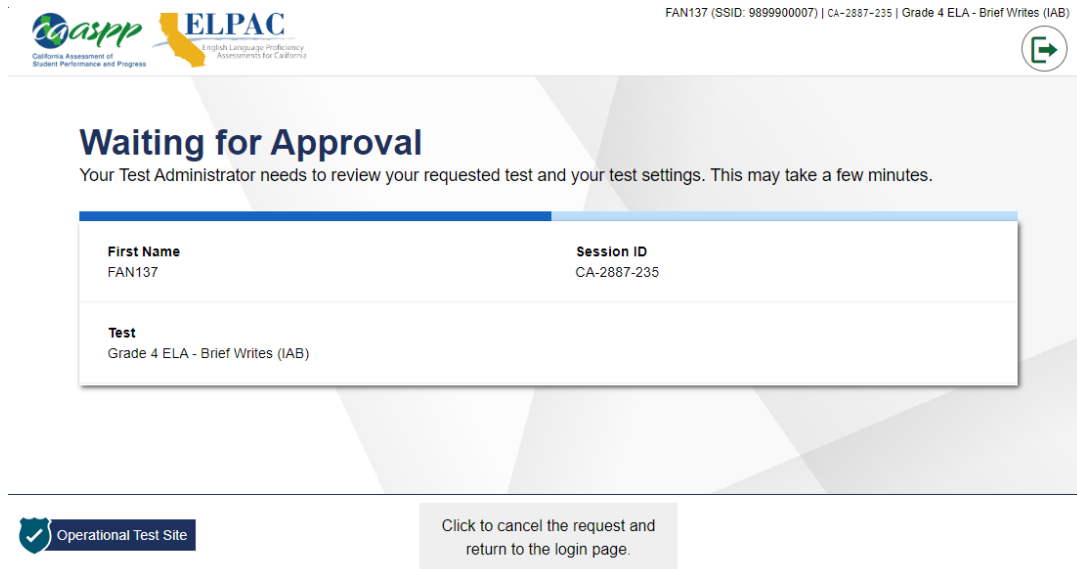


Figure 5. Waiting for Approval screen

- A student request is sent to the teacher and the student is taken to the *Waiting for Approval* screen (figure 5). The teacher must approve the student for testing before the student can proceed.

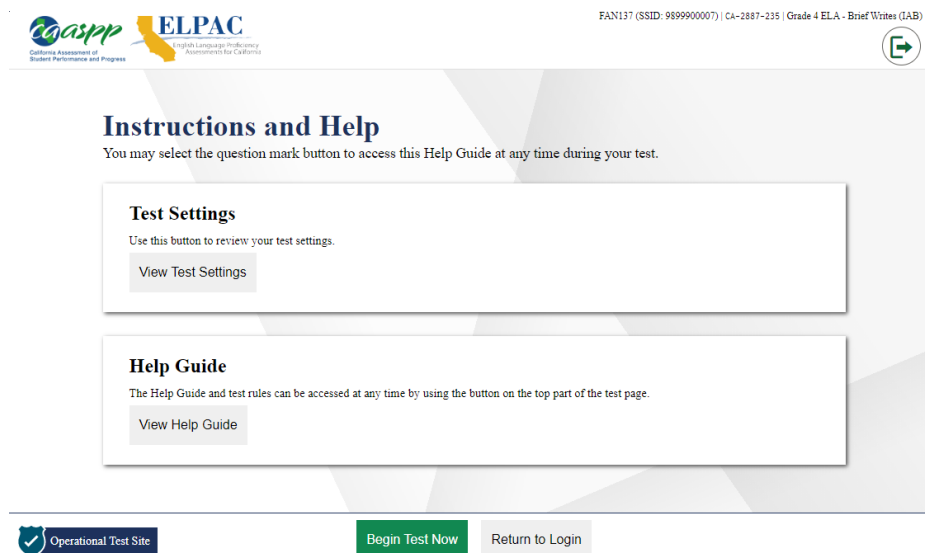


Figure 6. Instructions and Help screen

- Once the teacher gives approval, the *Instructions and Help* screen appears (figure 6). Select the **[Begin Test Now]** button.

Test questions will appear on the screen. Students can test normally as if they were in school. Teachers will monitor the tests from their administrator computers.
